


What are we considering

 - Ecosystem, landscape, species, population and genetic








Forest patch area classes in 2018,



Under threat


- Climate crisis, pollution, land-use changes, IAS
- IUCN evaluated 454 native species in Europe: 58% threatened (Sorbus covers 170 of the 454 species)
- 42% of extinction risk of all native species
- Latest results from the reporting by MS to the Habitats Directive
