The **LIFE TOKEN CO<sub>2</sub> Final Conference** will take place in Brussels as the closing event of the European LIFE TOKEN CO<sub>2</sub> project. The event will present the project's main results and open a dialogue on innovative tools for climate action and sustainable forest management.

The final conference of the LIFE TOKEN CO<sub>2</sub> project will bring together consortium partners, representatives of the European Commission and key stakeholders working in climate action, sustainable forest management and environmental innovation.

The event will mark the conclusion of a European project focused on validating an advanced CO<sub>2</sub> life cycle model and a digital platform designed to support more efficient, sustainable and transparent forest management. During the conference, the main results achieved, the tools developed and the opportunities for transferring and replicating the model in other European territories and contexts will be presented.

The conference will also provide a space for discussion on the role of forests in climate change mitigation, the generation of reliable and non-speculative carbon credits, and the contribution of innovative digital solutions to the European objectives of climate neutrality, sustainability and environmental resilience.
